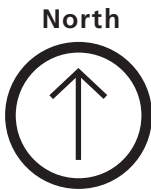

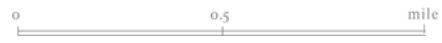

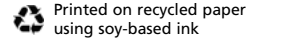

- **Camping** is by permit only. To reserve a space for Kirby Cove call (800-365-CAMP), for all others sites call Marin Headlands VC at (415) 331-1540. Camping brochure available at VC or online. Pick up our camping brochure at the Visitor Center.
- **Shortcuts** cause erosion. Please stay on the designated trails.
- **Bicyclists** may not exceed 15 MPH and must slow to 5 MPH around corners or while passing other trail users.
- **Dog walkers** must obey regulations and pick up after their pets.
- **National Parks** are protected areas. Take only pictures, leave only footsteps.
- **Point Bonita Lighthouse** is open to the public on Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays from Noon-3:30 p.m.
