The Suisun Marsh Natural History Association is a non-profit 501(c)3 membership organization. Incorporated in 1977, the Association offers vital assistance to injured and orphaned wildlife in Solano County, many affected by human activity.

A committed staff of volunteers, trained and ready to care for rescued wildlife, insures that birds and animals receive the best care possible. Since opening, over 200 species of birds, mammals, and reptiles have been treated; and we have released over 30,000 back to the wild.

Environmental Education

The Environmental Education program offers both slide shows and field trips to private and public schools and organizations.

Our major focus is on the Suisun Marsh - with many other natural history areas and subjects offered. Education has been a primary element of the Association's efforts, with over 12,000 children and adults currently participating annually.
